UCL-90 LD/UCL-67 LD

Remove six M2x4 fixing screws from the lens barrel by #0 Phillips precision screwdriver. Then, remove a "spacer" under the "LD Bayonet Mount" by removing six fixing screws. Keep removed screws/LD Bayonet Mount/spacer as they are necessary when you need to install the "LD Bayonet Mount" again. When you re-install the LD Bayonet Mount, put the LD bayonet Mount so that the guide on the "LD Bayonet Mount" locates as shown in below image.



If you have any difficulty to unscrew M2x4 fixing screw(s), do not proceed any further. as you could damage fixing screw(s) and the original "M67 Screw Ring"/"LD Bayonet Mount" can not be separated from UCL-90/67 M67, UCL-90/67 LD. Please consult with your purchasing dealer for advice.

Put grease in the screw holes of the lens barrel Apply grease <u>(supplied with an underwater case</u>) in six screw holes



3) Attach "XD Mount Spacer" on the lens barrel Put the "XD Mount Spacer" on the lens barrel as shown in the image so that screw holes both on the "XD Mount Spacer" and lens barrel are matched then fasten them with packaged M2x4 fixing screws (<u>do not use removed screws here</u>) by using a precision screw driver #0.

to avoid anchoring of fixing screws.


When tightening M2x4 fixing screws, tighten them evenly by drawing star pattern not too tight not to damage the lens itself.

4) Attach "XD Bayonet Mount" on XD Mount Spacer

Align the outer six threaded holes on the XD Mount Spacer with the six holes on the "XD bayonet mount" so that the guide on the "XD Bayonet Mount" locates product name (UCL-90, etc.) on the lens body.

Then, fasten them using the precision screwdriver #0 and the removed M2x4 screws.

When tightening M2x4 fixing screws, tighten them evenly by drawing star pattern not too tight not to damage the XD Bayonet Mount.
